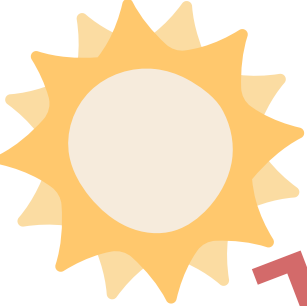


JUNE 21 JUNE SOLSTICE

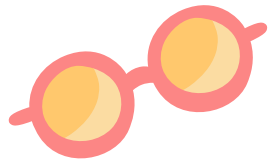
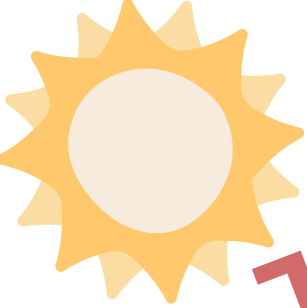
