

became a beloved ambassador for sea ofter awareness and



- Sea otters can hold their breath underwater for
 5 minutes, and they can dive as deep as 300 feet.
- Sea otters have the densest fur of any animal, with up to one million hairs per square inch! Their hair is so thick that even though they spend most of their time in the water, their skin stays warm and dry.
