Folding Instructions for letter or legal size paper.

Print on letter-size paper for practice folding.

Your printer may not align perfectly

Line A and Line B folds should fall in the exact center of the paper.
Line C folds should fall in the center between Line B and the center of the paper.

Line A

1st step – fold Line A along the center lengthwise so that you have a strip 4.25” high by 11” or 14” long.

- 2nd step – fold Line B so your paper is now 4.25” high and 5.5” or 7” long.
- 3rd step – fold Line C.
- 4th step – now unfold completely and fold Line B again.
- 5th step – using scissors, cut carefully along Line A from just before Line C to just a hair past Line C.

- 6th step – unfold and let the paper fold naturally along line A, letting the folds on Line B spread outward. Grasp the paper lengthwise and gently push toward the center until the pages lay flat. The folds along Line B should gape open and collapse as you push.
- 7th step – fold again on Line C to form your book.
- 8th step - optional, you can put a touch of glue inside the front and back panels to insure the booklet cannot be unfolded.

Tips

- Be sure to print in landscape.
- You may have to set your printer for borderless printing.
